ADJECTIVES

→ A demonstrative adjective points out a specific noun and helps to identify it. It always comes before a noun and specifies which.

[The word demonstrative means 'pointing out']

- This man is braver than Bali.
- That boy is lazy!
- These mangoes are sweet.
- Those mangoes are sour.
- Such men are dangerous.
- Yonder house is mine.

**NOTE** : 1. Demonstrative Adjectives answer the question: 'which?'

2. This and that are used with singular Nouns; these and those with plural Nouns.
