Cardinal numbers & Ordinal numbers

Numbers 1,2,3,4.....,9,etc are called cardinal numbers.

An ordinal number is a number that indicates the position of an object in a list.

Such as: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th etc.

(Refer Page – 24 of your maths book)

For example: 1st – first

2nd – second

3rd - third

4th - fourth and so on.

2nd - **second**

6th - **sixth**

10th - **tenth**
