THE CORRECT USE OF SOME ADJECTIVES

→ much, many : much means 'a large quantity of'; many means 'a large number of', much is used before uncountable nouns, many before plural countable nouns; as,

- There is not much tea in the pot.
- He has not many friends.

→ some, any : To express quantity some is used in affirmative sentences, any in negative sentences.

- There is some ink in the bottle.
- There is not any ink in the bottle.

→ A few : A few denotes some at least: a small number, however few. It has a positive meaning. We use a few with plural countable nouns.

- He has a few friends in the United States.
- A few men live a pious life.

→ A little : A little denotes some at least. It has a positive meaning. We use a little with singular uncountable nouns.

→ Elder, older; eldest, oldest - Elder and eldest are used for persons only, they denote the position of one member of a family with reference to another or other of the same family. 'Elder' is never followed by 'than'. Older and oldest are used for both persons and things.

- He is my elder brother.
- Raman is Ashok's eldest brother.
- He is older than his sister.
- He is the oldest man in the village.
