This tells us that Raghunath was a materialistic person who values wealth in life. He was foolish because he was chasing materialistic things in life.



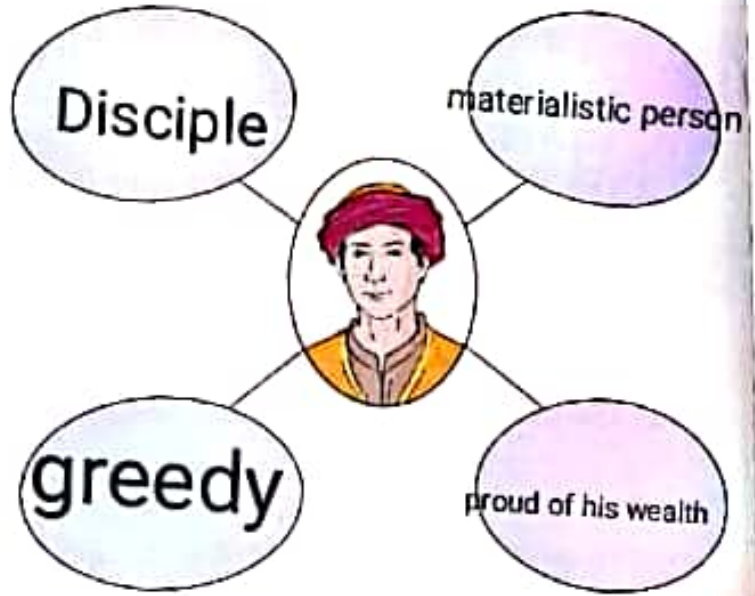
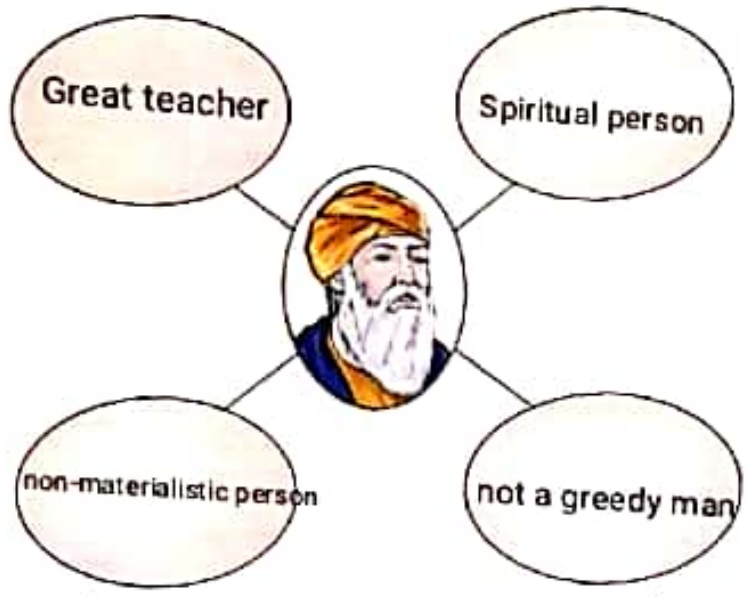
